Christine Miller's Reel

A 32 bar reel for four couples in a longwise set.

Bars

1-8 All four couples join hands and set twice with four Pas de Basque steps,
then cross over with the right hand for four skip-change of steps to partner's place

9-16 Repeat bars 1 to 8 back to place.

17-24 First couple lead down the middle, followed by the 2s, 3s and 4s, and cast back up round the fourth couple's place on the outside of the set to all finish back in their own places.

25-32 First couple cross over giving right hands for two steps and cast off to the bottom of the set for two on opposite sides, then dance a half figure of eight up round the fourth couple finishing in fourth place on their own side.

Second, third and fourth couples join hands to move up on bars three and four.

This dance was composed as a **Beginners'** dance, concentrating on **Pas de Basque** with nothing much else to worry about.
